

Navy Expected to Implement New Security Processes

Naval Air Station North Island (NASNI), Calif., has tested an electronic identification system for base access, dubbed "Smart Gate."

Smart Gate can be manned or unmanned. When unmanned, it allows access to those with a special vehicle decal and proper identification card. At the gate, a bar code reader will scan the decal. After verification, the person is allowed to advance to another reader where the process repeats with the member's ID card. The person is then granted access to the base.

Vehicles without decals must enter through the fully-manned gate.

For intruders, hydraulic bollards are ready to deploy in less than half-a-second to deny access.
